

Terms and Conditions for the 23rd World Scout Jamboree

1. Participants Ages

1.1. Boy/Girl Scouts Ages

Young people aged between 14 and 17 years old at the start of the camp (that is those born between 27th July 1997 and 28th July 2001) may take part in the 23rd World Scout Jamboree as participants.

1.2. Leaders Ages

Participants must be accompanied by the previously indicated numbers of leaders. Leader must be born on or before 26th July 1997, and at least one of the leader in unit must be aged 20 years old or above, which means they must be born on or before 26th July 1995.

1.3. IST Ages

Rovers/Scout Leaders who wish to participate in the Jamboree aged 18 and above (those born on or before 26th July 1997) can apply to be members of the International Service Team (IST).

2. Fees

2.1. Registration Fees

Fees for Participants and Unit Leaders is JPY 25,000.00.

2.2. Fee includes:

- The Jamboree Programme
- All meals for the duration of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree from dinner on 28th July 2015 until lunch on 8th August 2015.
- Upon arrival, transport from one of the specified Jamboree entry points to the Jamboree site.
- At the end of the Jamboree, transport from the Jamboree site to a specified Jamboree exit point.
- Unit camping kit, including cooking equipment. Medical care in the case of illness (excluding pre-existing conditions) or accidents, including minor surgery or treatment when necessary during the period of the World Scout Jamboree. Medication and any costs relating to hospitalization are NOT included in the fee.
- A World Scout Jamboree participation pack, including a neckerchief and a handbook.

2.3. Tentative Cost to travel to Jamboree:

Tentative cost (subject to change) as of 12th August 2014.

2.4. Deadline

2.5. Late Deposit:

Any late deposit (deadline 30th January 2015) of participants are subject of the 5% surcharge of registration fee.

2.6. Refund policy

Once fee deposited to Nepal Scouts account, fee will not refunded.

3. Registration Process

3.1. Permission of Participation

Permission of Participation will be granted by National Headquarters only when all the necessary procedures, including payment of the full fee. Any paperwork, including visa invitation, will be only processed after such procedures are completed.

3.2. Sending Registration Form

Each contingent from District members must submit individual registration form of participants by 1st January 2015.

4. Contingent :

Size of each patrol must consist 9 boy/girls and each Patrol accompanied by 1 Unit Leaders.

5. International Service Team (IST)

5.1. Fee :

Fees for IST is JPY 25,000.00.

5.2. Fee includes:

The fee for members of the IST includes:

- Briefing and training (including role specific training) prior to the arrival of participants.
- The Jamboree IST experience, including a programme of activities for when not required to work.
- All meals for the duration of the 23rd World Scout Jamboree from dinner on 25th July 2015 until lunch on 9th August 2015.
- Upon arrival, transport from one of the specified Jamboree entry points.
- At the end of the Jamboree, transport from the Jamboree site to a specified Jamboree exit point.
- Basic medical care in the case of illness.
- A World Scout Jamboree IST Experience pack, including a neckerchief and a handbook.

5.3. Registration Process:

5.4. Deadline

5.5. Late Deposit:

Any late deposit (deadline 30th January 2015) of participants are subject of the 5% surcharge of registration fee.

5.6. Refund policy

Once fee deposited to Nepal Scouts account, fee will not refunded.

5.7. IST Opportunities

In the registration, members of the IST will choose 3 different roles. From the list, Human Resources department will allocate each member to 14 departments. Please note SAJ will respect choices of departments, but cannot guarantee that everyone will be allocated to the desired department. Some roles require professional skills or qualification, and IST members will be asked to submit copies of relevant document to certificates to the Jamboree Office through NHQ.

5.8. IST Schedule:

1st January 2015: The deadline for contingent registration via DHQ.

April – May 2015: Allocation of IST members

May – June 2015 and onwards: Allocation of the IST member will be notified to Nepal Scouts NHQ from SAJ.

6. Jamboree Site:

6.1. Venue:

Jamboree site is located in Kirara-hama. It is a reclaimed land in Yamaguchi City, which is located in the western part of Honshu, extending about 1 km from north to south and 3 km from east to west (286 ha), and is equipped with developed facilities and parks.

6.2. Entry Points:

Transport to and from the designated entry points is included in the Jamboree fees. For IST members, transport will be available on 25th and 26th (AM) of July and on 9th of August. For participating Scouts and Unit Leaders, transport will be available on 28th and 29th (AM) of July and 8th of August.

Fukuoka Airport is a 2 hour drive away from the Jamboree site and has direct flights to Incheon (Seoul), Hong Kong, Manila, Bangkok, Taipei, Singapore and 12 other Asian cities.

Yamaguchi Ube Airport is 30 minute drive away from the Jamboree site has 9 flights to and from Tokyo daily.

Shin-Yamaguchi Station (Japan Railways) will be the main gateway for Contingents travelling by train. Shin-Yamaguchi station is about 4.5 hours from Tokyo and 2 hours from Osaka by Shinkansen (bullet train).
